Regency Beauty Institute Security Information

Annual Disclosure of Crime Statistics

Each year Regency Beauty Institute (“Regency”) prepares a security report to comply with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act. The full text of this report is located on Regency’s website at www.regencybeauty.com/security/. This report is prepared by Regency personnel in cooperation with local law enforcement agencies in those areas where its campuses are located. Campus crime, arrest and referral statistics include those reported to Regency administration, campus managers and local law enforcement agencies.

Regency gives notification to each student and employee regarding how to access its report on crime statistics. Prospective employees may obtain printed copies of the report by requesting it from the Regency Human Resources Department at Regency’s Headquarters location. Prospective students may obtain printed copies of the report by requesting it from a campus manager. Information on where to obtain this report is also included in Regency’s employment application.

Reporting Crimes

Regency encourages its students, employees, guests and other community members to report crimes or potential crimes which occur on or near Regency campuses.

In case of an emergency, you should dial 9-1-1 immediately.

In the case of a non-emergency, students should notify their campus manager of the crime. The campus manager will then report it to Regency’s headquarters administration via the ticketing system.

Regency does not currently have a confidential crime reporting procedure. Further, Regency does not have a process in which pastoral or professional counselors can report crimes anonymously.

Access to Campus Facilities

Regency’s campuses are accessible to students and the general public during the hours of approximately 9 AM to 9 PM Monday through Thursday and 9 AM to 5 PM on Fridays and Saturdays. Outside of these hours, Regency’s campuses are secured by an alarm system and are accessible only to those with security permissions.

Regency does not have campus living facilities.

Regency does not have campus security personnel or employ a campus police force.

Criminal Activity Related to Off-Campus Functions

Regency does not offer off-campus functions or sponsor any off-campus organizations.

Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act

The Federal Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act requires institutions of higher learning to issue a statement in their annual security report detailing where members of their campus community can obtain information concerning registered sex offenders. Drug and Alcohol Free School Policy

Regency embraces the spirit of the public law that requires schools to provide a drug-free campus and workplace. Regency will abide by the law as outlined in this policy. As part of our philosophy, we are dedicated to the advancement and well-being of the population we serve. As such, all students and employees are encouraged to abstain from the use of illegal drugs and irresponsible use of alcohol. Students and employees are prohibited from the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled substance or alcohol anywhere on Regency property including grounds, parking areas, anywhere within the buildings, or while participating in school-related activities. Students and employees are also prohibited from being present on campus under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances. Students and employees who violate this policy will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment or enrollment. If there is a reasonable suspicion that a student or employee of Regency is under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance while on Regency’s premises, then the student or employee will be asked to leave for the day. Students will be required to clock out for the day.

Any student or employee who suspects either they or someone else may be at risk is invited to seek services that can be of help. Regency maintains drug and alcohol education information and a list of counseling and support services, which can be obtained from a campus manager.

Any students convicted for possessing or selling illegal drugs while receiving Title IV assistance will be ineligible for FSA funds based on the chart below:

**Note: if convicted of both possessing and selling illegal drugs and the periods of ineligibility are different, the longer penalty will apply*

Crime Prevention Programs

Regency is engaged in the Cut it Out program, a program of the Salons Against Domestic Abuse Fund dedicated to mobilizing salon professionals and others to fight domestic abuse across the United States. The program builds awareness of domestic abuse and trains salon professionals to recognize warning signs and safely refer clients to local resources. Regency has joined forces with Cut it Out and the National Cosmetology Association to educate communities about domestic abuse.

Regency campuses provide clients with information on preventing domestic violence. Campus staff explain the Cut it Out informational materials to students, and discuss the program’s focus on awareness and information sharing – not intervention or interrogation. In addition, Regency works with domestic violence prevention organizations local to individual campuses to provide students with training on the issue geared for salon professionals.
