

Student Financial Aid Rights and Responsibilities

Students' Rights Include:

- To know the cost of attending Regency;
- To know what criteria Regency uses to select financial aid recipients;
- To know what financial assistance is available, including information on all federal, state, private, and institutional financial aid programs;
- To know how financial aid is disbursed;
- To know Regency's criteria for selecting recipients of financial aid and determining the amount of awards;
- To know standards for satisfactory academic progress and criteria for maintaining aid eligibility; and
- To know the interest rate of any loan taken, when the loan needs to be repaid, the total amount that will need to be repaid, and when or whether cancellation or deferment provisions apply.

Students' Responsibilities Include:

- To read and understand all documents signed by you;
- To complete financial aid forms accurately and on time;
- To provide additional documentation, verification, corrections, and new information requested by Regency or the agency to which financial aid applications are submitted;
- To understand and comply with the standards for satisfactory academic progress; and
- To repay all student loans, notify your lender of changes in your name, address or enrollment status, and to complete exit counseling upon leaving Regency.
